


<u>Art</u>

William Mutua

Background Information

This unit, linking to our topic of Sensational Safaris, will teach the children about choosing, using and mixing their own colours to create quality art work that shows progression in skills. The children will have the opportunity to explore the work of William Mutua, a Kenyan artist. They will be working primarily in paint to create pieces in a range of abstract styles.





In this unit the children will...

- Use drawing and painting to develop and share their ideas, experiences and imagination.
- Develop a wide range of art and design techniques in using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space.
 - Learn about the work of a range of artists, craft makers and designers, describing the differences and similarities between different practices and disciplines, and making links to their own work.

By the end of this unit....

All children will:

- Mix colours.
- Create art works with the colours they have mixed.
- Learn about the work of artists.

Most children will:

- Mix a range of secondary and tertiary colours.
- Mix shades.
- Mix tints.
- Decide if colours are warm or cool.

Some children will:

- Discuss similarities and differences between different artists,
- Describe the work of an abstract artist.
