Background Information

Know the story of Lego.

Explain how the games played in the past are different to the games played today.

Create an accurate timeline on the evolution of Dolls

Some children will:

Create an accurate timeline on the evolution of Dolls and explain how they have changed.

Explain how and why the materials have changed when making toys.

Create an informative poster on Ole Kirk (the founder of Lego), explaining how he created Lego.
