#### Background Information

In this unit of work we are looking at the artist Vincent Van Gogh. We will be looking specifically at his style and comparing this to other artists such as Pablo Picasso. We will be taking inspiration from Van Gogh to create our own self-portraits looking at the different features of our faces.

Recognise a piece of artwork created by Vincent Van Gogh.

**Most children will:**

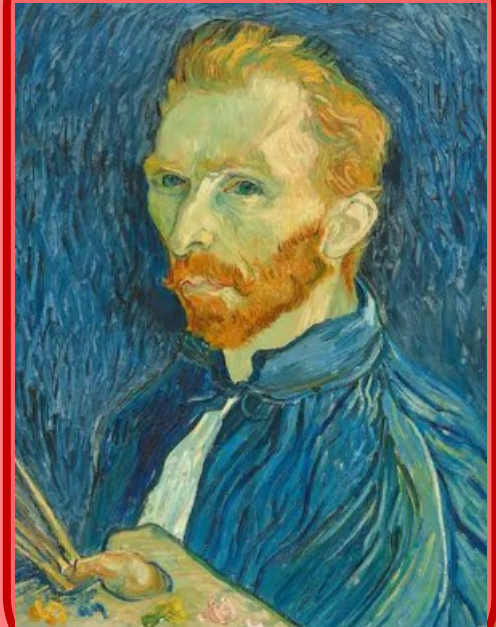
Explain what he/she likes about the work of others.
