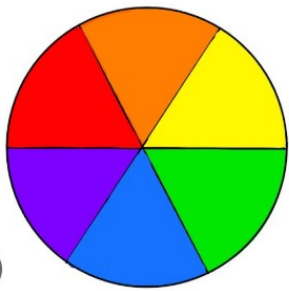


## Art

### The colour wheel- Wassily Kandinsky

#### Background Information

In this unit of work we are looking at the artist Wassily Kandinsky. We will be investigating the colour wheel, looking at the primary colours red, yellow and blue. We will be looking at the secondary colours purple, green and orange. We will also be creating split pin poppies for remembrance day.



#### In this unit the children will...

- Use a range of materials such as pastels, charcoal and paint.
- Use the colour wheel to influence choice of colour for painting.
  - Cut, glue and trim material to create an image.
  - 
  - Make structures by joining simple objects together.

Create a piece of artwork inspired by Wassily Kandinsky.

Recreate a piece of art by Wassily Kandinsky.

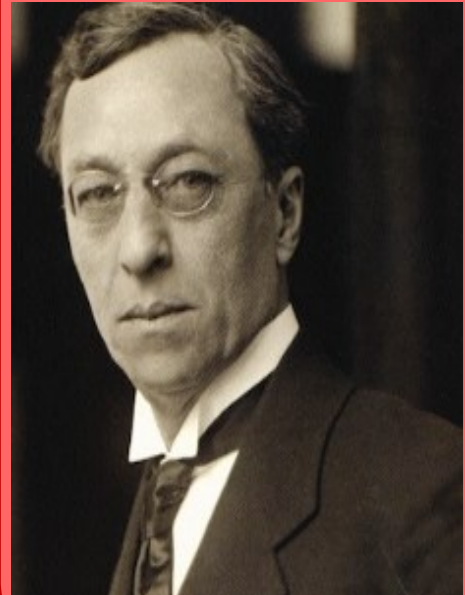
**Most children will:**
