### Background Information

In term 6 we look at both History and Geography. In Geography we are looking at the seaside near us. We will be extending our knowledge of the world around us building on what we have already learnt in Term 4.

In History we are looking at Space travel and how this has developed over time. We will be starting by looking at the first creatures sent to space all the way up to the last humans sent to space.



### In this unit the children will...

- Look at how Space travel has developed.
- Learn who and what has been to space.
  - Watch a modern day rocket launch.
- Learn about the different features of the sea side.
- Learn about the different seas surrounding the UK.

By the end of this unit....

All children can:

- Identify different features of a beach.
- Know the four nations that make up the UK.
- Learn the name of an astronaut.
- Identify the safety features of a space suit.
- Decide if they want to go to space.

Most children will:

- Explain the different features of a beach.
- Know and Identify the four nations of the UK on a map.
- Learn the name and a fact about an astronaut.
- Identify the features of a space suit and a rocket.
- Create an accurate timeline on the history of space travel.

Some children will:

- Identify and explain multiple features of a beach.
- Know and identify the four nations as well as the capital cities in the UK.
- Learn the names, facts and key dates about famous astronauts.
- Decide if they want to go to space and explain their reason coherently.
